WASHINGTON, DC – The Hispanic Heritage Foundation (HHF) today announced Oscar Nominee Edward James Olmos and Award-Winning Actress Judy Reyes as host of the 2014 Hispanic Heritage Awards Presented by Target on September 18 at the Warner Theatre in Washington, DC, which will be broadcast on PBS as a one-hour special nationally on September 29 at 10 p.m. ET (check local listings).
