Directed by Quique Avilés and Matthew Vaky, **Running the Fight** addresses the issue of guns and gun violence and the impact on our community. The presentation is performed in English with some Spanish and contains strong language. **Admission is free.**

"The vast majority of those involved in Paso Nuevo," states director Quique Avilés, "have been touched in one way or another by guns and violence here or in our home countries. The culture of violence is not limited to the use of weapons, but also includes the physical and psychological abuse to which we are subjected on a daily basis. After much discussion and exploration during the process, the Paso Nuevo participants decided to write individually or in teams the monologues and scenes that will be presented in **Running the Fight**."
